

We are positive that the combined endeavours shall bring about the desired all-around development of the child.




ACTIVITY- 1- Make a beautiful wall hanging and write five vowels on it with the help of given picture.




ACTIVITY- 2- My Alphabet Tree

Skills Developed - Gross motor Skills, Social skills, Thinking skills, Cognitive skills.


Practice makes perfect and we know that it's true when it comes to maths. So, let's practice addition with this fun "Paper Plate Addition Game".

This fine motor Maths fact activity is a hands-on way for kids to practice Addition. It's so easy to set up and lots of fun.

Material Required - Paper Plate, Buttons, black marker and dice.


How to make – Use black marker to draw a line across the centre of your plate. Next draw a line to divide the top half again. See the image for an illustration. Write a Plus sign between top parts

How to Play –Roll one dice, place that number of buttons in the first section of your plate. Roll the dice again. Place that number of buttons in the second section. Add the two sections together and put the correct number of buttons in the bottom half of the plate. Remove the buttons and play again


Make working model of PLACE VALUE CHART.


Material: Chart Paper, Black Marker

SIZE: 4 strips of 3x 20 inch


4 triangles of 4x4x4 inch
