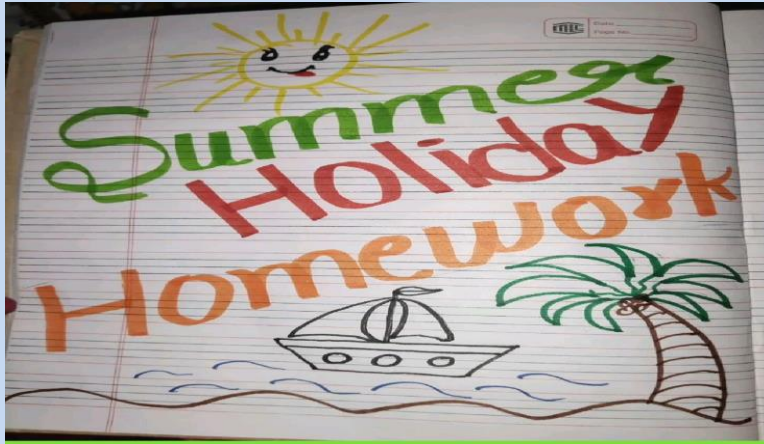

Q. Perform a Hands-on Activity to Show the Conditions Required for Seed Germination.

Set up 4 different conditions:

Setup 1 (All Conditions Present): Wet cotton + seeds (Keep in a warm place)

Setup 2 (No Water): Dry cotton + seeds (Keep in a warm place)

Setup 3 (No Air): Wet cotton + seeds (Cover tightly)

Setup 4 (No Warmth): Wet cotton + seeds (Keep in a cold place / refrigerator)

Seeds that can be used - Moong (Green Gram) – Rajma (Kidney Beans) , Chana (Chickpea)

Observation (After 3–5 Days):

Prepare a table with columns :

- 1) Setup
- 2) Conditions
- 3) Observation/Result
- 4) Mention which setup showed best growth and why?

Instructions:

- * Click and add real photos of your experiment.
- * Label each setup clearly
- * Keep your work clean and well-organized
- * Use colors to make it attractive

Roll Numbers	Project Title	Instructions
1 – 10	The Dream Room Designer	Draw a "Bird's Eye View" (top view) of your dream room using only 2D shapes (squares, rectangles, circles). Label the furniture and create a "Shape Count" list.
11 – 20	The Master Chef's Menu	Help prepare a no-cook snack (like lemonade or fruit salad). List 5 ingredients with their measurements (e.g., 250ml milk, 4 spoons sugar). Draw your creation!
21 – 30	The Data Detective	Interview 10 people about their favorite summer fruit. Create a Tally Mark table and represent the results in a colorful Bar Graph.
31 – 40+	The Symmetry Safari	Find 5 objects in nature or around your house that are symmetrical (e.g., a leaf or butterfly). Draw them and mark the dotted Line of Symmetry.
